7. How do the memorial stones of Joshua 4 compare and contrast with the sacraments of baptism and the Lord's Supper?
8. What is the significance of the meaning of the name *Gilgal*? Describe an experience of reproach being rolled away in your life. How lasting were its effects?
9. What can we learn by passing on important truths to the next generation?
10. How does the concept of sharing our testimonies with others align with the principles found in this passage?
