

Who is Malachi?

- His name means "My Messenger". He is not mentioned anywhere else in the Old Testament.
- He was the last of the writing prophets but wrote nothing about himself. We have no biblical information about his ancestry, call, or personal life.
- Jewish tradition identifies him as a member of the Great Synagogue that collected and preserved the Scriptures.
- Looking solely at internal evidence, the date of the prophecy points to the late fifth century B.C., most likely during Nehemiah's return to Persia c. 433-424 B.C.
- Malachi was the last prophet Judah heard until John the Baptist came and the prophecy of Malachi 3:1 was fulfilled.
- Contemporaries: Possibly Nehemiah and Ezra.
- Scriptural Context: Nehemiah 10-13.
