

Psalm 96 Discussion Questions

Application-Focused Discussion Questions: Sing, Sing, Sing!

1. What is one practical way you can intentionally obey the command to “sing to the Lord” this week, even outside of a church setting?
2. When you don't feel like worshiping, what specific truth about God's greatness can you remind yourself of to help reorient your heart?
3. What is one “idol” (distraction, priority, or habit) in your life that competes with your worship, and how can you actively replace it with praise this week?
4. How can you intentionally reflect on God as Creator in your daily routine and turn that into worship?
5. Is there a truth about God you struggle to express in prayer? How might singing or listening to worship music help you express that more fully?
6. When you sing in church, are you more focused on yourself or on God? What is one change you can make this Sunday to engage more meaningfully in worship?
7. In a current challenge you're facing, how can you actively declare “the Lord reigns” through your attitude, words, or worship?
8. How can you join in creation's “song” this week by living in a way that reflects joy, gratitude, and praise to God in your everyday life?
9. If Jesus were to return soon, what would you want to change about your worship life right now? What step can you take today toward that change?
10. Have you personally placed your faith in Christ? If so, how is that reflected in your worship? If not, what is holding you back from responding to Him today?
